Subject: Status of the University.


Sir,

With reference to your letter No. AU/UGC/03/2016/472 dated 16.3.2016 on the above subject, I am directed to say that Adesh University, Bhatinda, Punjab, established by an Act of State Legislature of Punjab as a Private University and is empowered to award degrees as specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956 through its main campus in regular mode with the approval of Statuary Bodies/Councils, wherever its required.

Adesh University, Bhatinda, Punjab is not authorised to open study centre/off-campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State as per the judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yashpal vs. State of Chhattishgarh. The University cannot open its centre(s) even within the state as per the provision of UGC (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 without the approval of UGC.

The UGC has not granted any approval to the University to open off-campus/study centre.
