### PROGRAMME, ELIGIBILITY AND FEE STRUCTURES

#### 1. Fellowship in Assessment of Health Professions (FAHP)

(a) No. of seats : 20

(b) Distribution of seats : SC 25%  
BC 10%  
PwD 5%

(c) **Eligibility criteria:**

Post Graduates in Medicine/ Dentistry/ Nursing/ Physiotherapy/ Pharmacy/ Paramedical Sciences/ Allied Health Sciences with 3 years of post PG teaching experience and currently teaching in any of these institutes as Assistant Professor or above.

(d) Medium of instruction for study and evaluation will be English.

(e) Duration : 1 year

(f) **Fee structure:**

For internal candidates : 40,000/-for entire course

For external candidates : 50,000/-for entire course

For Overseas candidates: 75,000/-for entire course

Registration number will be allotted by university with the verification of following certificates:

1. Qualification certificate/ post graduation degree
2. No Objection Certificate indicating experience and current designation from controlling officer (Registrar/ Dean/ Vice Chancellor/Principal)

(g) **Details of course**

(i) The course will comprise of 2 contact sessions- 1<sup>st</sup> session of 4-5 days at the beginning and 2<sup>nd</sup> session of 2 days at the end of the tenure.

(ii) One project proposal will be submitted during first contact session. The students will carry the project work in the next 6-8 months under the guidance of faculty. The project report will be submitted before 2<sup>nd</sup> contact session.

(iii) 10 months will be dedicated for covering following topics:

1. Principles of Assessment of Health Professions
2. Assessment of Cognitive Domain
3. Assessment of Psychomotor Domain

4. Assessment of Affective Domain (including communication, professionalism and ethics)
5. Competency Based Assessment
6. Workplace Based Assessment
7. Question Paper Setting
8. Programmatic Assessment
9. Using assessment as a Learning tool
10. Putting in Action

(iv) Topics will be covered by online asynchronous discussions and assignments. There will be written assignments covering various topics and both individual and group assignments will be done.

(v) Students will be required to submit the project report and also present the poster during 2<sup>nd</sup> contact session.

(vi) Students will also submit printouts of the assignments at the time of 2<sup>nd</sup> Contact Session.

**(h) EVALUATION:** Final evaluation will be based on:

(i) Participation in online and onsite discussions/ formal lectures/ practice sessions: 3 Credit hours.

(ii) Assignments: 3 Credit hours.

(iii) Project submission and evaluation through the office of Controller of Examinations (Evaluation by internal teachers only): 2 Credit hours.

(iv) Poster presentation: 2 Credit hours.

**(i)** Students will be encouraged to publish their project work and also remain in discussion forum if they desire.

**(j)** Final certification will be by Adesh University which is a UGC recognized University.
